DESCRIPTION

The Telecor Display Phone Model DP300 is a full feature speakerphone designed to be used with the Telecor VS Series of Telephone Systems.

The DP300 is equipped with an easy-to-read 2x20 character LCD display, which provides valuable information about the calls that are being handled. When the phone is in the idle state, the user's name, extension number and date are displayed, along with the DND and Call Forwarding status of the instrument. When a call is received, the display changes to show information about the caller (internal, external call and associated information). A pair of Feature Buttons (A & B) are provided to be used in conjunction with the display. Pressing the "A" Feature Button switches between the Text Message and the Caller ID number display. Pressing the "B" Feature Button enables users to view the status of their Voice Mail.

The DP300 is equipped with 5 Incoming Line Appearance Buttons that can be programmed to accept up to 5 incoming calls. Three of the five Appearance Buttons can also be customized to be used as Direct Station Select/Busy Lamp Field Buttons (extension view).

Twelve standard Feature buttons offer instant access to common operating functions. Six custom Feature buttons enable the user to assign most commonly
